



RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT BSA-2026 TO J.F. Kiely Civil, LLC FOR HOUSE CONNECTION LATERALS AND LINE EXTENSIONS

WHEREAS, the Beachwood Sewerage Authority solicited public bids in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., for Contract BSA-2026 for House Connection Laterals and Line Extensions; and

WHEREAS, bids were publicly received and opened on December 16, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. at the offices of the Beachwood Sewerage Authority; and

WHEREAS, one bid was received from J.F. Kiely Civil, LLC., 1 Radar Way, Tinton Falls, New Jersey 07724; and

WHEREAS, J.F. Kiely Civil, LLC submitted a base bid in the amount of \$145,677.00 for Year 2026, \$187,670.00 for Year 2027, and \$203,670.00 for Year 2028, for a total contract amount of \$537,017.00; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer, CME Associates, together with the Authority Adjuster, have reviewed the bid submission, supporting documentation, and bid tabulation, and have determined that the bid submitted by J.F. Kiely Civil, LLC. is responsive to the bid specifications and that said bidder is responsible in accordance with applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer has recommended award of the contract to J.F. Kiely Civil, LLC, and such recommendation has been reviewed and concurred with by the Authority Adjuster; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer or other proper financial officer of the Authority has certified the availability of funds for this contract as required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Beachwood Sewerage Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENTS AND ACKNOWLEDGING CORPORATE RESTRUCTURING OF CME ASSOCIATES, LLC TO ARTHEON, INC.

WHEREAS, the Beachwood Sewerage Authority has previously retained **CME Associates, LLC** for professional engineering services pursuant to duly authorized agreements, including but not limited to the 2025 and 2026 Consulting Engineer agreements and related project authorizations; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has been notified that **Consulting and Municipal Engineers (CME)**, together with affiliated entities, has undergone a corporate restructuring whereby CME Associates, LLC is now operating under and as a subsidiary of **Artheon, Inc.**, with Artheon, Inc. serving as the parent entity; and

WHEREAS, said restructuring includes the transition of employees, operations, and billing functions to Artheon, Inc., with no anticipated disruption in services, personnel, or project performance to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, **CME Associates, LLC** and **Artheon, Inc.** have formally requested the Authority's consent to assign all existing contracts, amendments, work orders, and purchase orders to Artheon, Inc., with Artheon assuming all obligations thereunder; and

WHEREAS, the assignment request expressly provides that all existing agreements shall remain in full force and effect, without modification of terms, and that the Authority's rights shall remain unchanged following the assignment; and

WHEREAS, the contracts subject to assignment include, among others, the 2026 Professional Engineering Services Agreement, prior engineering service agreements, and ongoing project authorizations as identified in Schedule 1 of the submitted materials; and


WHEREAS, **Artheon, Inc.** has provided supporting documentation evidencing its corporate standing, business registration, insurance coverage, and compliance with State of New Jersey requirements, including but not limited to a Business Registration Certificate, Certificate of Employee Information Report and insurance certifications demonstrating

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Beachwood Sewerage Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Authority hereby consents to the assignment of all existing contracts, agreements, amendments, work orders, and purchase orders between the **Beachwood Sewerage Authority** and **CME Associates, LLC** to **Artheon, Inc.**
2. The Authority acknowledges that **Artheon, Inc.** shall assume all duties, obligations, and responsibilities under said agreements, and that all terms and conditions of the existing agreements shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
3. The Authority further acknowledges that such assignment shall not constitute a termination, modification, or novation of the existing agreements, but rather a continuation thereof with **Artheon, Inc.** as the performing entity.
4. The Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Consent to Assignment of Contracts and any related documents necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
5. The Secretary is hereby directed to retain copies of all assignment documentation, corporate certifications, insurance certificates, and related materials on file with the Authority.
6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
