WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that an adjustment to compensation is appropriate and in the best interests of the Authority;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Beachwood Sewerage Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The annual salary of Patricia Grodberg is hereby set at \$55,000.00 per year.
2. This salary adjustment shall be retroactive and effective as of March 1, 2026.
3. The Authority's payroll provider is hereby directed to implement this salary adjustment, including all necessary calculations and payments to account for the retroactive increase effective March 1, 2026.
4. All prior resolutions or portions thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby amended to the extent necessary to effectuate this Resolution.
5. The appropriate officers and professionals of the Authority are hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to implement the terms of this Resolution.

AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION AND DISPOSAL OF OBSOLETE JOHN DEERE RIDING LAWN MOWER

WHEREAS, the Beachwood Sewerage Authority utilizes equipment for the maintenance and operation of Authority facilities and grounds; and

WHEREAS, the Authority owns a John Deere riding lawn mower used for grounds maintenance operations; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that the mower identified below has become obsolete, unserviceable, or no longer economically repairable and is no longer suitable for continued operational use; and

WHEREAS, continued storage of the equipment serves no operational purpose and unnecessarily occupies Authority storage space; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to remove the equipment from service and authorize its lawful disposal in accordance with proper public asset management practices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Beachwood Sewerage Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Authorization of Disposal

The chairman of the Beachwood Sewerage Authority is hereby authorized to remove from service and dispose of the following equipment determined to be obsolete and unserviceable:



WHEREAS the Authority has determined that the listed pumps should be removed from service and disposed of as surplus or scrap in a manner consistent with applicable New Jersey law and proper public asset management.



AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR LEGAL SERVICES IN THE MATTER OF
CORSI v. BEACHWOOD SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS the Beachwood Sewerage Authority retained the law firm of Levin Shea Pfeffer & Goldman, P.A. to provide legal services in connection with the matter captioned Corsi v. Beachwood Sewerage Authority, Ocean County Docket No. OCN-DC-17383-25; and

WHEREAS said legal services included, but were not limited to, review and analysis of the complaint and applicable ordinances, legal research, preparation and filing of pleadings including an Answer, Counterclaim, and Motion to Dismiss, preparation for and attendance at court proceedings, post-court filings and correspondence, and final closure of the matter; and

WHEREAS Levin Shea Pfeffer & Goldman, P.A., through Ian Goldman, Esq., submitted a final invoice dated March 2, 2026, itemizing professional legal services rendered between November 19, 2025 and March 2, 2026; and

WHEREAS the invoice reflects a total of 10.5 billable hours at an agreed hourly rate of \$175.00, for a total amount due of \$1,837.50; and

WHEREAS the Authority has reviewed the invoice and finds the services rendered to be reasonable, necessary, and directly related to the defense and resolution of the above-captioned matter; and

WHEREAS the Authority desires to authorize payment of the final invoice as submitted and to formally close the professional services engagement for this matter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Beachwood Sewerage Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows.

1. The Beachwood Sewerage Authority hereby authorizes payment to Levin Shea Pfeffer & Goldman, P.A., in the amount of \$1,837.50, representing full and final payment for legal services rendered in the matter of Corsi v. Beachwood Sewerage Authority, OCN-DC-17383-25.
2. The services compensated by this Resolution were billed at a rate of \$175.00 per hour and total 10.5 billable hours, as set forth in the firm's final invoice.
3. The Chairman is authorized to approve payment, and the Authority's Treasurer and staff are authorized to process payment in the ordinary course.


WHEREAS, the various outstanding checks have been investigated and it has been determined that these checks should be cancelled; and

**RESOLUTION GRANTING LIMITED INTEREST RELIEF AND EXTENDED PAYMENT PERIOD
TO 1136 Windward Ave.**

WHEREAS, the Beachwood Sewerage Authority is responsible for billing, collection, and enforcement of sewer user charges pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that the account for the property located at 1136 Windward Avenue, Beachwood, New Jersey, owned by Ashley K. Thompson, was affected by a lack of data entry by a prior Authority employee, resulting in the account being inactivate; and

WHEREAS, upon reactivation, quarterly bills were sent covering periods in which arrears had accrued, specifically beginning with the first quarter of 2025; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has petitioned the Authority for equitable relief, asserting that the billing circumstances arose through no fault of the owner, and requesting accommodation in the interest of fundamental fairness; and

WHEREAS, the Authority recognizes that it is appropriate to afford relief in this instance in order to balance fairness to the customer with the obligation to preserve the financial integrity of the system; and

WHEREAS, the Authority finds it in the public interest to establish a defined payment arrangement that will allow the property owner to satisfy all arrears without interest within a reasonable period of time, while preserving the Authority's right to impose interest should the payment plan not be honored.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Beachwood Sewerage Authority as follows:

1. The property owner, Ashley K. Thompson, for the premises located at 1136 Windward Avenue, shall be permitted a one-year period, commencing March 18, 2026 and ending March 17, 2027, within which to pay in full all arrears that accrued for the billing periods beginning with the first quarter of 2025 and continuing through the first quarter of 2026.
2. No interest or late fees shall be applied to the arrears identified above, provided that the entire arrears balance is paid in full on or before March 17, 2027, and provided further that all subsequent quarterly sewer charges coming due after March 18, 2026 are timely paid when due. In the event that the arrears are not paid in full by March 17, 2027, then interest and late fees shall be retroactively calculated and applied as if no relief had been granted, commencing from the original date of delinquency, being the first quarter of 2025.

5. This resolution is adopted as a matter of fundamental fairness based on the unique circumstances affecting this account, and shall not be construed as establishing precedent for any other account or customer of the Authority.




