RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SALARY ADJUSTMENT FOR JAMES CARLIN

WHEREAS, the BEACHWOOD SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, previously employed James Carlin as a Line Maintenance Assistant; and

WHEREAS, the Authority recognizes and appreciates the successful completion by James Carlin of Ocean County Vocational Technical School coursework and training relevant to his employment and operational responsibilities with the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that an adjustment in compensation is appropriate in recognition of the successful completion of said coursework and the value of such additional training and education to the operations of the BEACHWOOD SEWERAGE AUTHORITY; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has further determined that said salary adjustment shall be retroactively applied effective May 1, 2026, upon confirmation of successful completion of the applicable Ocean County Vocational Technical School courses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the BEACHWOOD SEWERAGE AUTHORITY, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, that effective May 1, 2026, the annual salary of James Carlin, Line Maintenance Assistant, shall be increased to the sum of \$58,166.00 per year, retroactive to said date upon successful completion of the applicable Ocean County Vocational Technical School courses; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all appropriate payroll adjustments necessary to implement this Resolution are hereby authorized and directed; and

RESOLUTION OF THE BEACHWOOD SEWERAGE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR MASONRY WALL REPLACEMENT TO BRICKWORK MASONRY

WHEREAS, the Beachwood Sewerage Authority (“Authority”) required certain masonry wall replacement work in connection with Authority facilities and operations; and

WHEREAS, the Authority’s Engineer, Artheon, solicited and received quotations for the proposed masonry wall replacement project; and

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated April 30, 2026, the Authority Engineer advised the Authority that two (2) quotations were received for the project, consisting of a quotation from Brickwork Masonry in the amount of Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$5,250.00), and a quotation from Best Pro Construction LLC in the amount of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer reviewed the submitted quotations for compliance with the project specifications prepared by the Engineer’s office and discussed the project with both contractors; and

WHEREAS, the Authority Engineer recommended that the contract be awarded to Brickwork Masonry, 4060 Ivins Avenue, Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey 08234, as the lowest responsible quotation received; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has reviewed the anticipated cost associated with the project and has confirmed that sufficient funds are available and have been appropriated or otherwise authorized for the undertaking of the masonry wall replacement project; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has reviewed the recommendation of the Authority Engineer, has confirmed the availability of funds necessary to undertake the project, and has determined that it is in the best interests of the Authority to authorize the award of the contract to Brickwork Masonry, subject to the contractor providing all required licensing, insurance, and any required bonds or other documentation deemed necessary by the Authority.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Beachwood Sewerage Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Authority hereby authorizes the award of the contract for masonry wall replacement work to Brickwork Masonry, 4060 Ivins Avenue, Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey 08234, in the total contract amount of Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$5,250.00).
2. The award authorized herein is made in reliance upon the recommendation of the Authority Engineer and shall remain expressly subject to the contractor providing

5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
